Cargill Izegem is part of the Cargill Oils & Seeds business. In Izegem vegetable oils are refined and bottled. We are aware that our activities have an influence on: emissions to the air and water, energy consumption and the creation of waste.

Responsibility.

The environmental policy applies to all activities including management, office services, factory activities and purchasing.

The environmental coordinator has the responsibility to monitor the effectiveness of the objectives. However, all employees have the responsibility to ensure that the purpose and objectives of this policy are met in their work environment.

Objectives

The following objectives have been set:

- Efficient use of natural resources by saving energy and water, reducing waste and, where possible, recycling.
- Keep noise pollution to a minimum.
- Keep light nuisance to a minimum.
- Keep odour nuisance to a minimum.
- Keep impact on surface waters as low as possible and under control.
- Prevent soil pollution
